Directions & Parking Info - From the East: Drive west on Interstate 44 past the DaimlerChrysler plant. Exit at Bowles Avenue and continue west on North Highway Drive to the overpass. Turn left at the light, crossing over I-44 and turn left on South Highway Drive. Continue east on South Highway Drive to the Maritz entrance # 6. Turn right at entrance # 6. You may park in any open space either on the east, south or west side of the building. The main lobby entrance is on the south side.

From the West: Drive east on Interstate 44 to Highway 141. Exit at 141, but do not turn on 141. Continue through the intersection east bound (past the restaurants) along South Highway Drive. The Maritz Campus begins at the next light. Continue east on South Highway drive to the Maritz entrance # 6. Turn right at entrance # 6. You may park in any open space either on the east, south or west side of the building. The main lobby entrance is on the south side.
